Linguistics of ASL: Aspect With Elisa Maroney

Saturday, April 18, 2009; 8:45 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

In this workshop, the presenter will share research findings on aspect in American Sign Language (ASL) that shines new light on the topic of aspect in ASL, tangibly anchoring this current knowledge in cross-linguistic research. These findings show that ASL users have a range of options to produce aspectual meanings, including verb reduplication, aspectual verbs, adverbial signs and phrases, aspectual nouns, and combinations of the above. Participants will have the opportunity to practice interpreting aspectual categories between ASL and English.

Elisa M. Maroney has a Ph.D. in linguistics from the University of New Mexico, an M.A. in Linguistics from Gallaudet University, and a B.S. in Speech Language Pathology from the University of the District of Columbia. She is an Associate Professor in the ASL/English Interpreting Program at Western Oregon University and has been interpreting and teaching for 20 years. She holds Certificates of Interpretation and Transliteration, National Interpreter Certificate, and Ed: K-12 certification from the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf and the American Sign Language Teachers Association Qualified certificate. She has served on the Commission on Collegiate Interpreter Education as a Commissioner since its inception in 2006.
