NIC Performance Preparation **Friday, September 25, 2009** **5:45 – 9:00 p.m.**

This workshop will provide participants with opportunity to become familiar with the format and criteria of the Performance portion of the RID NIC exam. Participants will have an opportunity to assess their own interpreting skills using the criteria, to practice one or more of the following: ASL-to-English, English-to-ASL and/or interactive texts, and to receive feedback within the parameters of the criteria.

Pre-requisite: Participants must have passed the written portion of the NIC exam or hold other RID certification that exempts them from taking the NIC written exam.

NIC Interview Preparation **Saturday, September 26, 2009** **8:45 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.**

This workshop will provide participants with opportunity to become familiar with the domains on the RID NIC Interview Rubric and to practice for the interview portion of the NIC exam. Participants will learn how to think globally and identify critical elements that must be included in high quality responses. Working in triads or dyads, participants will practice answering interview questions following the format of the NIC exam.

Pre-requisite: Participants must have passed the written portion of the NIC exam or hold other RID certification that exempts them from taking the NIC written exam.
