RID NIC Preparation Workshop: Written, Performance, Interview With Joe Lucas

Friday, March 14, 2008; 6:15-8:30 pm
Saturday, March 15, 2008; 8:45 am – 4:30 pm

This workshop is designed to give participants an overview of the national testing system process and format by reviewing the written, interview, and performance portions of the NIC exam. **Friday night** will be a review of the written text format and suggested study materials for the exam. This will jump start the preparation process for participants who are studying for the exam. Julie Simon will co-present on Friday night. On **Saturday** much of the workshop will focus on the interview portion of the exam with lecture, demonstration, and small group activities. Participants will learn how to think globally and identify critical elements that must be included in high quality responses. The format and the domains that are rated for the performance will be reviewed and participants will have an opportunity to ask questions about the performance. Notes: 1) There will not be hands-on practice for the performance portion of the exam. 2) This workshop does not cover other RID exams.
