Sharon Neumann Solow works as an interpreter, interpreter coordinator, performer, lecturer and consultant. Her career has taken her around the United States, and to Canada, Mexico, Europe, Scandinavia, New Zealand and Australia. She is the author of two books, Sign Language Interpreting: A Basic Resource Book (newly revised!) and Say It With Sign along with a number of professional articles and handbooks. She is a working interpreter, mostly in legal and conference settings, with a long history of classroom interpreting and interpreter training and administration. Sharon is an active member of the RID (Registry of Interpreters of the Deaf) and CIT (Conference of Interpreter Trainers), holding the Specialist Certificate: Legal as well as NAD's SIGN (Sign Language instructor) Comprehensive Permanent Certificate. In 1987, Sharon received the national Virginia Hughes Award for outstanding contributions to the field of sign language interpreting.
